Significant Events:

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers handled the below incidents and seized the following drugs, money and/or weapons.

April 13, 2018:

Search Warrant – Robbery Suspect

On April 13, 2018, S/Cpl. Sowden and other Elsmere PD officers executed a search warrant in the unit block of 9th Avenue in the City of Wilmington. S/Cpl. Sowden had developed a second suspect from the USA Gas robbery last month. The juvenile suspect was not at the residence at the time of the search warrant, but a black BB gun matching the description of the weapon used during the robbery was located. Robbery warrants have been obtained for the second juvenile suspect.

April 19, 2018:

Marijuana Arrest

On April 19, 2018, Patrolman MacDowell conducted a motor vehicle stop after observing the operator later identified as 28-year-old Danny Cleaver of Wilmington not wearing a seatbelt. As Patrolman MacDowell made contact with Cleaver he observed him attempting to conceal what later turned out to be 8 ounces of marijuana inside his shirt. Cleaver was charged with Possession of Marijuana in a Tier 1 quantity, Possession of a controlled substance, providing a false statement, hindering prosecution as well as the seatbelt violation. As a result of the investigation Cleaver's vehicle and \$1,225.00 dollars were seized as proceeds of his drug sales. Cleaver was arraigned on the charges and bail was set at \$32,001.00 cash and was remanded to the Department of Corrections.
