Suspects Identified In Vehicle Break-Ins

On September 21, 2018, Lt. Shelton and Detective Sowden responded to several complaints regarding vehicle break-ins that took place throughout the Town of Elsmere. From processing the scene each Officer was able to lift prints from Donmire Williams, 18 of the Unit block of E. 25th Street in Wilmington, from two separate vehicles that were broken in to. With that information and from speaking with other Police Agencies it was determined that Donmire along with Purcell Hocker-Osborne, 19 of the 200 block of 5th Avenue in Wilmington and Nyeem Parks, 20 of the 200 block of W. 22nd Street in Wilmington were responsible for the vehicle break-ins. As a result of the investigations Donmire, Purcell, and Nyeem were charged with the following:

- 3 Counts of Burglary 3rd Degree
- 3 Counts of Criminal Trespass 2nd Degree
- 1 Count of Theft Over \$1,500
- 2 Counts of Theft Under \$1,500
- 1 Count of Conspiracy 2nd Degree
