A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A “STOP SIGN” AT THE INTERSECTION OF HALL AVENUE AND ALVIL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have been made aware that a traffic safety situation exists which creates a high risk that an accident could occur; and

WHEREAS, the Elsmere Bureau of Police have surveyed the area and determined that the most effective manner of reducing the potential that an accident could occur would be to install a “Stop Sign” at this location.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELSMERE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a “Stop Sign” be installed on Hall Avenue at Alvil Road.
2. The Public Works Department is directed to consult with the Public Safety Department and coordinate installation of the sign as soon as possible.
