January 22, 2022:

On Saturday, January 22, 2022 at approximately 2:00 p.m, officers were called to the 1400 block of Maple Avenue in Elsmere for a physical domestic dispute. Upon arrival, the investigation revealed a male subject named DaiJour Chase, 23, of the 100 block of Gladstone Way, Newark, was involved in an altercation with his girlfriend and others and a knife was involved. The officers encountered Def. Chase and attempted to arrest him. After a lengthy foot pursuit, the defendant was placed into custody.

The investigation revealed that during the argument the door to the residence was smashed in, the victim was held against her will inside the residence and a fight ensued involving a butcher knife. Def. Chase was charged with the following offenses: Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony; Home Invasion Burglary First Degree Causing Physical injury; Assault Second Degree; Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Person Prohibited; Unlawful Imprisonment First Degree; Noncompliance with Conditions of Bond; Endangering the Welfare of a Child; Resisting Arrest; and, two counts of Criminal Mischief.

Def. Chase was committed to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution after failing to post \$44,300.00 CASH BAIL.
