A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A “NO PARKING” ZONE ALONG A PORTION OF TAYLOR ROAD

WHEREAS, the development of Rosemont has two parts; and

WHEREAS, the only access to the rear of the development is to cross a bridge on Taylor Road; and

WHEREAS, the Elsmere Fire Company has recently purchased a new Tower Truck which is having difficulties navigating into the rear portion of the Rosemont Development due to the slope and design of the roadway at the intersection at Taylor Road and Rosemont Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to assist the Elsmere Fire Company in providing necessary services to the residents of Rosemont should an emergency arise.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL, THAT;

1. That a “No Parking Zone” is hereby established on the South Eastern curb line of Taylor Road from its intersection with Rosemont Drive and continuing Easterly for a distance of 20 feet to the bridge on Taylor Road.
