Significant Events:

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers handled the below incidents and seized the following drugs, money and/or weapons.

Subject Jumps From Rt. 2 W/B Viaduct

August 11, 2022:

On Thursday, August 11, 2022 hrs, at approximately 10:40 pm officers were dispatched to the Elsmere Viaduct for a report of a person about to jump off the bridge. Upon arrival, officers found a 20-year-old male who had jumped just prior to officer's arrival. The subject had obvious signs of fractures and was unconscious. However, he was breathing and had a strong pulse. The victim was transported to the hospital and his family was notified.

The victim was placed in a medically induced coma. Doctors were very optimistic that the victim will recover, but it will be a long road.

Shplifting Results In Drug Arrest

August 17, 2022:

On Wednesday, August 17, 2022 hrs. at approximately 1:15 am PFC Linde and Officer Rosa were sent to the Elsmere Wawa for a theft in progress. Wawa staff provided officers with a description of the suspects involved. Upon arrival to the scene, PFC Linde observed the suspects enter a Nissan Altima displaying registration that belonged to a Ford Explorer.

Officers conducted a traffic stop in the area of Rigdon Road and Hall Avenue. Upon speaking to the driver, a search the vehicle was conducted. During a search, officers located approximately 20 prepackaged bags of marijuana and additional drug

paraphernalia. The driver, Def. #1; Karron Reed-Lewis of Philadelphia was arrested for the drugs and paraphernalia.

Officer Rosa was able to develop probable cause to arrest Def. #2; Jacquan Wood of Philadelphia for shoplifting. Def. #2 (Wood) was also found to be wanted by Philadelphia, PD for smuggling contraband. However, Philadelphia declined to send the required paperwork in a timely manner, and Wood was summons and released for Shoplifting under \$1,500 (M/A) and personal use marijuana (Civil Citation).

Def. #1 (Reed-Lewis) was charged with Possession With the Intent to Deliver, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Fictitious/Cancelled Registration. Def. #1 (Reed-Lewis) was issued a total of \$3,000.00 secured bail for this incident.
