Online Payment Plan

Who is eligible? Anyone who has received a Voluntary Assessment Center mail in fine and the age of the ticket is 30 days or less.

How does this work? The court will allow you to go online and place your VAC ticket on a payment plan anytime within 30 days from the date the ticket is issued.

The max number of payments allowed is six. Payments are divided into 6 equal payments. The first payment will be due on the original date specified on the ticket, with additional payments due every 30 days thereafter. You can pay the balance in full anytime within the 180-day period.

How to Set up online payment plan: Go to courtpay.delaware.gov (Welcome to e-Payment). Select “Deferred Amount”. If option is not available, then the ticket does not qualify for online payment plan.

You may contact the VAC at 302-739-6911 to assist you with setting up an online payment plan; or make a payment over the phone using a Visa/MasterCard/Discover credit card during normal business hours of Monday-Friday from 8am-4pm.
