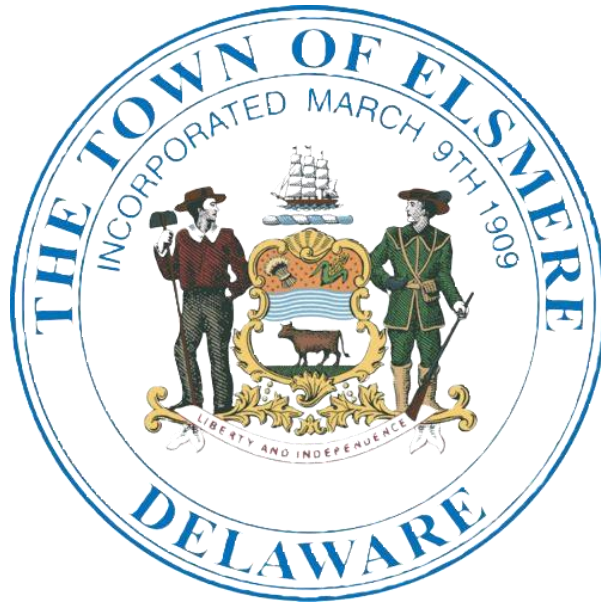

TOWN OF ELSMERE ORDINANCE 692

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTIES FOR PROHIBITING CERTAIN FACIAL COVERINGS FROM BEING WORN IN CERTAIN SPACES; UNDER CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Elsmere passed Ordinance 683 which prohibited certain facial coverings from being worn in certain spaces; under certain times and conditions, which took effect on September 8, 2025.

WHEREAS, following its adoption, a typographical error was identified in the text of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to amend the ordinance solely to correct the typographical error without changing the intent or substantive provisions of the ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELSMERE, THE FOLLOWING:

Paragraph 3 shall read as follows:

“A person who violate Paragraph (1) of this Section shall be subject to a fine (Fined) not less than (seventy-five dollars (\$75).) and not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).”
